4.7 million people in the United States are bitten by a dog every year.



Personal injury can have short-term and long-term effects on injured individuals including:

- Significant Medical bills
- Lost Wages due to Missed Work
- Impairments Caused by Personal Injury including physical, cognitive, sensory, and psychological.

Filing a Personal Injury Claim

Indiana's Statute of Limitations

According to Indiana Code section 34-11-2-4, Indiana's statute of limitations for personal injury cases is set at two years, meaning you have two years from the day of your accident to file the initial court documentation.
